

## PE Daily Schedule and Classroom Management Plan

### Daily Schedule

The daily schedule for all 3 PE teachers is listed on the specials schedule (which I have attached)

### Classroom Management

- Class Rules- Class rules are clearly posted on a white board at the front of the gym where students line up.
- Class incentives- Each class is listed on a scoreboard that is posted at the front of the gym. Each class enters the Gym with a total of 3 points (Because the expectation is that they should follow all of the rules and show good sportsmanship). Classes will be given a warning if a yellow card is flashed by the PE teacher. The class will lose a point if a red card is shown by a PE teacher. If classes earn 30 points, they then get to choose the activity for the next PE class.
- Individual Incentives- The PE teachers work in conjunction with the classroom teachers in using the clip charts. Students who are caught following directions, showing good sportsmanship, or helping other students will have an opportunity to clip up. Students who may need a gentle reminder to listen, follow directions, or keep their hands to themselves might be asked to move their clip down.
- Behavior Report- Students who make 3 inappropriate choices in PE will need to fill out a behavior report which needs to be signed by a parent and returned to the PE staff.
- Parent Contact- Both positive and negative parent contact will be made at the discretion of the PE staff as needed.
- Health Classes- Since health takes place in the teacher's classrooms this year, a combination of that classroom teacher's rules as well as the health educators rules will be utilized to manage a classroom.
- Reports- PE teachers will report behavior back to the classroom teacher who will use the reports to influence any classroom incentives that they are implementing.
